Health & Safety Procedures

Classroom Instruction

The CDL program will follow all procedures listed in the master SCTC Health & Safety Plan.

In addition, the yellow phase requires that class size be limited to 25 or fewer students for in-person instruction.

The classroom will be set up to limit seating to one chair per table, and students should use the same table during each classroom session.

Hands-On Instruction

During the yellow phase, road and range training should be limited to one instructor and one student in the truck at the same time. Universal masking, when feasible, is required during the yellow phase but must be handled in accordance with applicable highway safety standards and DOH and CDC guidelines.

SCTC will implement a standard cleaning protocol for all phases that includes disinfecting the steering wheel, gear shifter, etc. after each individual completes seat time. Hand sanitizer will also be kept in the truck and should be used upon entrance to and exit from the truck.

When possible, students will be divided into smaller driving cohorts, in order to promote social distancing and limit personal interactions that encourage the transmission of COVID-19.
